- To deliver high quality, specialized Applied Behavioral Analysis services and provide support to individuals diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD) and their families in a respectful and professional manner. We are committed to teaching skills that will provide a foundation for our students to become independent, productive, and integral members of the community to the best of their abilities. Independence is maximized through educational programs and services, as well as cultural and vocational opportunities that include various community partnerships.
